12. Announcement of upcoming congresses in 2026 and 2028

13. Announcement of congress chair and co-chair for the 42st SFOMK Congress in 2026

14. SFOMK scientific scholarship.

The research project «Identification of potential biomarkers and molecular signatures for diagnosing and stratifying sicca patients" with principal investigator **professor Janicke Liaaen Jensen**, Department of Oral Surgery and Oral Medicine, Faculty of Dentistry University of Oslo is granted 3000 Euro with the following motivation:

The planned multidisciplinary research is a true translation project ranging from lab bench to patient treatment, using the very latest technology, where the results bare the possibility to not only increase the understanding of sicca patients but also to improve diagnosis. Furthermore, if disease specific biomarkers can be identified this may have the potential for precision treatment based on non-invasive sampling.

15. Miscellaneous

The general assembly was concerned about the recruitment of members and especially the younger ones.

Several proposals came up to retain and recruit members.

There are many hospital employees in SFOMK and we need to profile ourselves broadly as an association.

Proposals were made on both travel grants for educational candidates as well as giving the residents a seat on the board.

There was also a proposal to share national meetings via the websites in the respective countries.
